STATISTICS

By the 1st of January 2016 there have been registered 10213 people with HIV infection, 7331 of them are alive and know about their status. The estimative number of people living with HIV in Moldova exceeds 18 000. This means more than half of people living with HIV in our country do not know their status.

Each year there are officially registered about **800 new HIV cases**, more than 60% of them are already in an advanced stage of the disease called AIDS. About 70% of HIV positive people are co-infected with Hepatitis C. The most common cause of death among people living with HIV is tuberculosis. **Only 20%** of the estimated number **of people living with HIV in need of treatment receives it**. According to the estimation there are **30 000 drug addicted persons in Moldova**. Only **10500** people are **officially registered**. About **80%** of injection drug users are **co-infected with Hepatitis C**. Prevalence of HIV infected people among drug users is about 20%, which means one in five drug users is HIV infected.

According to the World Health Organization, there are more than **130 000 people infected** with hepatitis C in Moldova. The government can cover the treatment of only 300 infected people per year. The cost of this treatment for our country remains extremely high, since the quality and efficiency is poor. In 2015. 2870 persons with tuberculosis have been officially registered in Moldova. According to estimations, their number is about **4460 people**. Moldova ranks first country in European Region with the highest burden of multidrug-resistant tuberculosis. About one-third of all new tuberculosis cases and two thirds of the repeated return in treatment - are cases of multidrug resistance tuberculosis. The tuberculosis death rate is 20 cases per 100 000 population.

MAIN PROGRAMS we are working on



Community Systems Strengthening



We carry out round tables, workshops, trainings, offer capacity building for partner organizations, subgrants program, exchange of experience program and participation in international events. Forming Public Opinion



We implement large-scale campaigns with public figures and people living with HIV who are open about their status, informing civil society through mass media, organizing thematic actions.

Expansion & development of private partnership

We involve representatives of the business sector in the fight against the epidemic.



Involvement in public policy formation process



We participated in the development of standards and regulations for the provision of psychosocial support services, standards for sexual and reproductive health services for people living with HIV and people who use drugs. We initiated the elaboration and adoption of the social pension mechanism for supporting children with HIV and access to rapid HIV tests in pharmacies. We participated in the elaboration of three National HIV/AIDS Programs and National Gender Equality Program, in the country dialog on the development of two applications to the Global Fund, in the development of national protocols on methadone therapy, in the organization of National HIV/ AIDS conferences etc.

Social media

At the moment the Facebook page of "Positive Initiative" has more than $2\ 500$ likes. The average monthly reach of our audience is more than 1 000 people.

The closed Facebook group "My World" is accessible only for people living with HIV, drug users (actual or in remission), and their nearest surroundings, as well as for employees of AIDS service organizations. Currently the group has more than **400 members** from all regions of Moldova.

2012: The action "6000 waiting for a

verdict" was organized in order to attract the authorities' attention on the need of increasing the budget National HIV/AIDS program. Hundreds of people gathered in front of the Ministry of Health to hung funeral towels on the Ministry fence.

2012: Representatives of NGOs from all over Moldova gathered in front of the Ministry of Health to participate in the **"Pinocchio effect" action.** Participants pointed out on authorities' empty promises to allocate funds for the fight against HIV/AIDS.







2012: The action "Give kids the life" was organized by the community to protest against authorities' inaction, which results in lack of social support for HIV positive children.





2014: Action called "Stop burying people – ensure access to treatment"

was organized by activists, who staged a funeral procession on the main streets of Chisinau, in order to attract attention of general population, mass media and government on people with hepatitis C. Thousands of patients with hepatitis C are sentenced to death because of lack of governmental funds for disease treatment.

Throughout the lifetime of "Positive Initiative", we regularly hold **Seminars, educational trainings, multilateral working meetings,** as well as provide technical assistance to our non-governmental members and partners.
